Inspired by the Kabbalah's Tree of Life design. Medicinal plants to cure every illness can be found here.



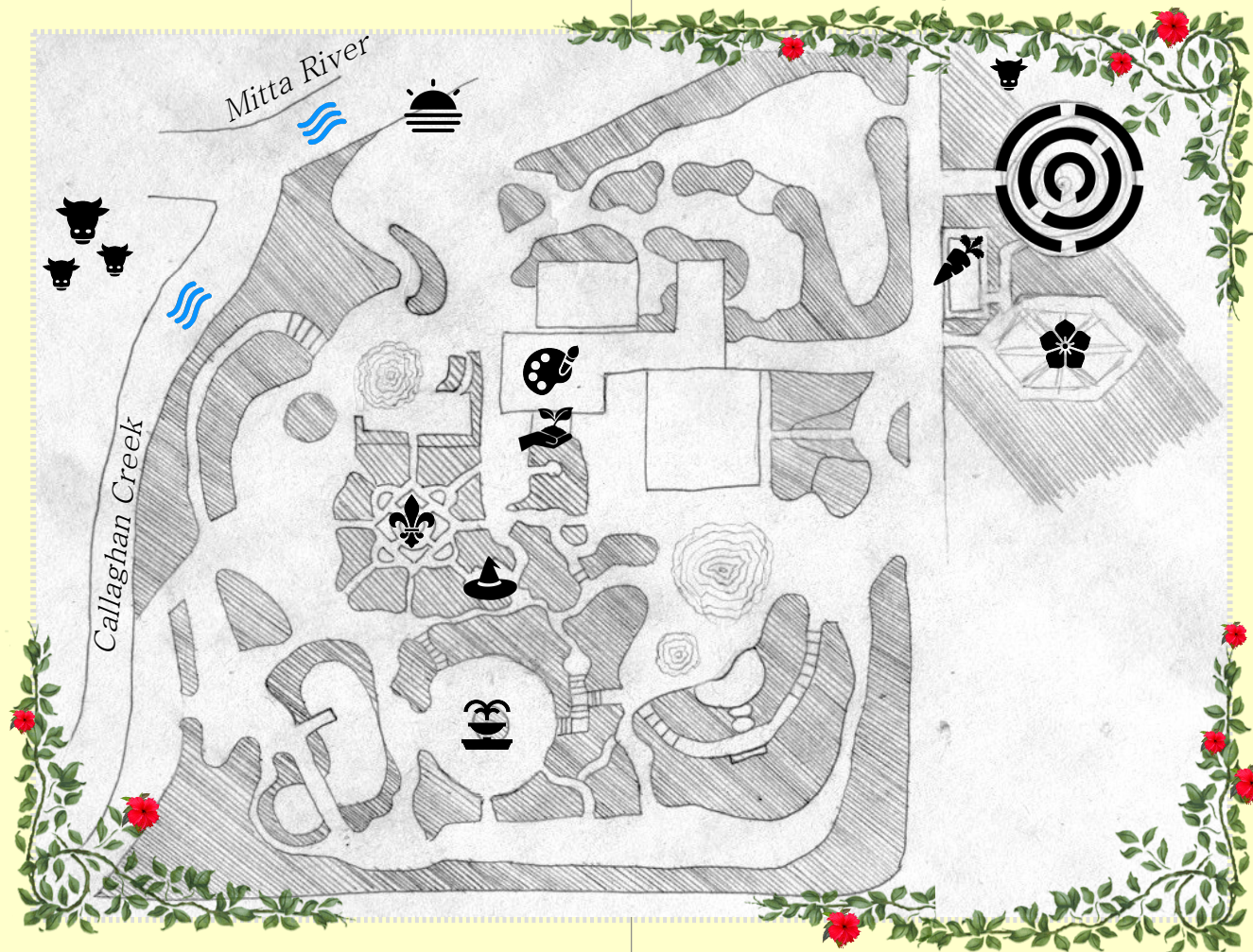
### The Vegetable Garden #8

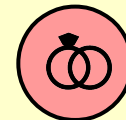
